I was just amazed at her talent, but in my eyes she could do anything.

Fifteen years after her death in 1987, I dug out her oil paints, which amazingly were still useable, thinking maybe I should give painting a try. Having retired a few years earlier I thought why not, and fortunately found a class with a great teacher. Well, I was hooked! Unfortunately I did not inherit her natural talent, but have been painting ever since. My ultimate goal would be to produce loose, transparent paintings, which to date I have not entirely achieved. I have always been told "it is just a piece of paper" if at first you don't succeed try, try again.


